



2017 Private Lessons and Fees

Lessons are primarily conducted before and during school hours.

Both group and private lessons are available and are usually scheduled on a fixed day with a rotating timetable to ensure that students do not consistently miss the same classroom or other College activity. Availability for outside of school lessons is limited with preference given to senior students and those taking multiple lessons.

Instruments available for Tuition

Individual or group lessons are available for all instruments except piano which requires individual lessons.

Fees

The outline of fees for 2017 is as follows:

- Individual lessons –\$30 per half hour each student
- Groups of two – \$17 per half hour each student
- Groups of three – \$12 per half hour each student (only for 1st year of Beginner Band)

**Changes in fees are at the discretion of the school*

Individual teachers will issue an account for lessons at the beginning of each term. For lessons to continue this account must be paid in full by its due date. This will usually be by the fourth week of the term. Tuition fees are to be paid directly to the instrumental music teacher.
