## Year 11 Web Preferences Portal

Your child will receive an email from Mr Hobson with a link that will give them access to the Web Preferences Portal. The process will be:

1. Student will access the portal and complete their subject selections, after consultation with their parent/caregiver.
2. Once the student has completed their subject selections they will need to enter a parent/caregiver email address for verification.
3. Parent/caregiver will receive this email from step 2 above and are required to click on the link provided in the email to endorse the subject selections.

In planning the subject line up for 2020 you will need to complete this subject selection process by **Monday, August 19 at 9:00am**. Please note the following points:-

- You will need to select **SIX** subjects to study. **ONE** from each block/preference area.
- You will be asked to choose a full (ATAR) subject pathway (General subjects) or a Non-ATAR subject pathway (Applied subjects and Certificate courses). Please note that the Non-ATAR pathway will allow you to select a combination of Certificate, Applied and General Subjects.
- Block A and Block B are compulsory blocks - there is NO External Subject option available for these blocks.
- You can choose to study an external subject e.g. certificate courses through TAFE or a school based traineeship or study through distance education or pursue a university scholar program during 11 & 12.
- If you wish to pursue an external study to complement your ATAR or Non-ATAR pathway please note your preference on the form in the elective block space provided.
- Students will only be permitted to drop a subject when their external subject become active.
- Each elective subject will only be offered if viable student numbers indicate.
- Parents must sign the form ensuring that they have been privy to this information / discussion.
- There is a limit of 10 opportunities to make your subject selections. That is you can change your mind up to 9 times (or August 19, 9:00am) before you will be unable to make further changes.
- Please talk with Mr Sheppard if you have any questions or need advice on career pathways.
- Please talk to Mr Hobson if you have any problems with the process of completing this online subject selection.
- Finally please make your decisions a matter of prayer - it is God that holds the future and He wants to hold your hand.
