Laptop Computer Acceptance Form – 2020

Please note: This form outlines main and additional points to the *ICT Handbook 2020 Student and Parents - ICT Terms and Conditions* document found online on the Northpine website. When signing this form you agree to abide by all the terms and agreements in the above mentioned document.

A. General

- This agreement begins on the date this form is signed and terminates on the final day of school in 2020.
- The cost of the **'ICT levy'** is in accordance with the College's published fee schedule. This includes the costs associated with the laptop, the ICT support and installed software.

B. Northpine Christian College - Level of Service Responsibilities

- The College will support the user and the computer within its warranty period at the specified support times within school hours. **Note:** Insurance does not cover intentional damage of the laptop and loss of accessories (bags, chargers and stylus pens).
- The College is committed to providing a safe environment for the use of ICT. This includes the Internet, which is logged and protected using Cyberhound School Internet Security & Filtering software.

C. Parents/Care Giver Responsibilities

- Parents have the full right and responsibility to manage the care and use of the laptop outside of school.
- Parents have the responsibility to ensure a level of **'cyber safety'** for the use of the laptop outside of school. For example: always keeping and using the laptop in a common area, disabling Internet access when not specifically needed and setting time restrictions for daily use.
- Parents are responsible for any additional costs not covered by the warranty. Please note that there is an **excess of \$60.50 (inc. GST)** for accidental damage insurance claims.
- Please note Year 9 students will receive a new laptop in Year 10 and are not eligible to purchase a three-year-old laptop from the College. Three-year-old laptops will be distributed throughout the college for educational use.
- As a good will gesture, parents of Year 12 students will have the opportunity to purchase a three-year-old school laptop for a set price. Please note your Northpine family fee account must be paid in full prior to the purchase of the device.
