
What's been happening?

RECIPE

Zucchini Slice

Ingredients

- 5 eggs
- 150g (1 cup) self-raising flour, sifted
- 375g zucchini grated
- 1 large onion, finely chopped
- 1 cup grated cheddar cheese
- 60ml (1/4 cup) vegetable oil

Method

1. Preheat oven to 170C.
2. Beat the eggs in a large bowl until combined. Add the flour and beat until smooth, then add zucchini, onion, cheese and oil and stir to combine.
3. Grease and line a 30 x 20cm lamington pan. Pour into the prepared pan and bake in oven for 30 minutes or until cooked through.
4. Once slightly cooled, Cut into pieces and enjoy 😊
