



Secondary Sport

Northpine Christian College offers a wide variety of sports and physical activities as part of the curriculum and pathways for students to be able to extend themselves.

Curriculum Overview

Compulsory Health and Physical Education classes form the basis for the skill development needed in many of the major sports to act as a platform for pathways into:

- QCE based Physical Education subjects
- Certificate 2 in Recreation
- Certificate 3 in Fitness in Year 11 and 12
- Competition sport at various levels.

Opportunities in Challenge also allows physical skill development in a wide variety of activities that help develop skills and coordination. Being a part of team through training for the Adventist Schools Sport Association Gala days provides a competition outlet for those students wanting to further develop their sporting skills as well as Middle/Senior Secondary Sport as regular competition that promotes skill development teamwork and resilience. Regular lunchtime competitions and school carnivals also provide regular outlets for students to challenge themselves to achieve sporting excellence.

District and Regional Sport

Swimming, Cross-Country, Athletics and most other popular team and individual sports are offered as part of the school's association with both the Pine Rivers District and the Sunshine Coast Zone District, which provides a pathway to Metropolitan North Sport and then State levels. All individual and team sports aside from Swimming, Cross Country and Athletics will need to be entered via tryouts at various times of the year.

ASSA

The Adventist Schools Sports Association has been a high level competition and one that Northpine continues to dominate in many areas of sport, in particular the Basketball component. There is a strong focus for performance in this avenue with teams going through a rigorous selection process and at least 5 weeks of training prior to each competition.

Basketball

Basketball at the college continues to provide students with the opportunity to participate in the BOSBL (Brisbane Outer Schools Basketball League) and the strong Northpine Basketball weekly competition. The college continues to broaden student opportunities in the future in a variety of different sports.

Inter-house Competitions

One of the biggest aspects of the sporting program at Northpine is the inter-house competitions. The 3 houses compete in 4 major carnivals in the year including; swimming, athletics, cross-country running and an adventure race. These carnivals are very competitive with the rivalry providing a fantastic platform to bring the school community together. Along with the 4 major carnivals, students compete in lunchtime competitions throughout the year in order to gain points for the overall house championship.



Other Opportunities

Northpine Christian College offers senior students a chance to train and compete in Rugby League through representing the school team the "Sharks". The team has performed at a very high level in the past and will continue to improve in the future.

Northpine also runs a fully functioning Gym for the Certificate 2 and 3 Fitness courses that operate at the College which provides an outstanding facility and small class groups to be able to focus on this area of development.

The College is proud of the Mountain Biking program and facilities that operate at the college. We have an outstanding mountain bike track and a full fleet of Mountain Bikes that give students even further opportunities both in classes and extra curricula activities.

Cross Country and Athletics Squad/Training are also developing which provide students to specifically train for the large sporting events of the year.
