## **HELPFUL INFORMATION ABOUT MUNCH MONITOR**

Munch monitor is the name of our online ordering system. Details about how to set up an account can be found on the school website in the tuckshop section.

***We would encourage anyone wanting to use tuckshop to set up an account, as we slowly move towards being cashless at school. EFTPOS is not available.***

***Snack money allowance*** is a feature on Munch Monitor, designed for parents/guardians to allow their children to have a set amount of money available for them to use to make their own purchases at the tuckshop. This can be either a weekly limit or a daily limit.

The ***Allergies*** section allows you to let us know if your child has an allergy or intolerance to certain foods. Please keep this updated if there are changes to this information.

***Gluten Free*** items are the first items listed on Munch Monitor. You will need to scroll past them to see all other items available for ordering.

In order to ***successfully order on Munch Monitor***, you should ensure the following:

1. Ensure that you have chosen the ***correct meal break*** tab at the top of the screen.
2. After you submit your order, you need to wait for the ***successfully submitted*** message to pop up on the screen.
3. ***Check the confirmation email*** that will be sent to you. If you have any queries about the order, we request that you call us as early as possible so that we can make any necessary amendments for you.

## **OTHER GUIDELINES FOR PRIMARY STUDENTS**

Prep and Year 1 students are not permitted to bring cash to the tuckshop to make purchases. They are only permitted to use their munch monitor snack money (if set up on their account) or have an order written by a parent.

Primary students will not be allowed to buy food for their friends. Although it seems a nice gesture, children don't always make the best choices, parents may not be aware that this is happening and there is always a danger with allergies.

Primary students are not permitted to purchase Iced coffee.

There is a limit of one ice-cream/ice-block or slushy per student.
